Word: **cruelty**

Definition: **behavior that causes pain or suffering to another; the condition of being cruel**

Sentence: **Some people display cruelty toward animals.**

Word: **ability**

Definition: **the quality of being able; able to do something**

Sentence: **He has the ability to earn straight A's.**

-ity/ty-"condition or quality of being

Word: **specialty**

Definition: **an area or skill in which one is an expert**

Sentence: **Making model airplanes is his specialty.**

Word: **novelty**

Definition: **the quality of being new**

Sentence: **The novelty of the job wore off.**

Word: **attentive**

Definition: **paying close attention to something**

Sentence: **The nurse was very attentive to the patient.**

Word: **cooperative**

Definition: **working together toward a common goal**

Sentence: **The librarian was cooperative in helping us find a book.**

Word: **sensitive**

Definition: **quick to detect or respond to slight changes**

Sentence: **The classroom teacher is sensitive to a child's needs.**

Word: **defensive**

Definition: **used or intended to protect**

Sentence: **The man on trial was very defensive.**

<p>Word: subfreezing</p> <p>Definition: under/below the freezing point.</p> <p>Sentence: In Antarctica, they had to endure subfreezing temperatures.</p>	<p>Word: subway</p> <p>Definition: a passage underground.</p> <p>Sentence: My brother travels to work on the New York subway.</p>

<p>Word: misspell</p> <p>Definition: to spell incorrectly</p> <p>Sentence: I hope I don't misspell any words on the test!</p>	<p>Word: misread</p> <p>Definition: to read incorrectly</p> <p>Sentence: Be careful to not misread the directions.</p>
<p>mis-: "incorrect/wrong"</p>	
<p>Word: misguide</p> <p>Definition: to offer incorrect guidance</p> <p>Sentence: Do not let the TV ads misguide you into buying cheap goods.</p>	<p>Word: mised</p> <p>Definition: to give someone the wrong idea about something.</p> <p>Sentence: The robber misled the cops with fake clues.</p>
